1. Tag Singing - Jim Bagby, David Krause

Do you find you can't wait to get to the end of a song, so you can enjoy the grand and glorious finish? In the Tag Singing room, all we sing are those great endings! We'll share the classics and new tags, with music and by ear. Join us to enjoy one of the best parts of barbershop singing!

2. Heritage of Harmony Sing – Bill Biffle, George Gipp, Rich Gray

A fun read through of BHS's 50th anniversary songbook, available from barbershop.org as a hard copy or download. Real barbershop songs arranged in the barbershop style for easy singing. Although a few books will be provided, bringing your own will be a sign of "judgment, brains, and maturity".

3. Discovery Singing (Woodshedding) – Toban Dvoretzky, Steve Shannon, Mike Ebbers, Brian Beck

Woodshedding is "discovery singing" – creating harmonies by ear without referring to existing arrangements. With a little practice, almost anyone can do it. It's how our hobby began. There is no feeling quite like ringing chords that you've discovered. Come and find this out for yourself.

4. Pickup Quartets - Roger Lewis, Rich Gray, Steve Shannon, Mike Ebbers

One reason to attend a barbershop gathering is to enjoy singing in a quartet. But what do you do if you didn't bring your quartet with you? Answer: you come to the Pickup Quartet event, be placed into a quartet, and choose, practice a song, and sing for the group.

5. Singing the Chestnuts – Joe Browne

The Barbershop Chestnuts are short arrangements of songs in traditional barbershop style. They are intended to illustrate what WBQA is trying to promote. In this session we will hand out and sing through several Chestnuts, all of which are available to members FREE! On the WBQA web site at www.sppbsqsus.org.

6. Lodge Forum – George Gipp, Kenny Hatton, Keith Richmond, Steve Shanon

Find out how the first Lodges were formed, how they did it, how they attract men to sing in their group. A great time for current Lodge officers and prospective Lodge leaders to come together to find out what works. A must for all Lodges to have a representative here to participate.
